#### Driving Instructions to Lincoln Community Center —

Take Kennedy Ave South (Indiana exit 3) from I80/I94. Continue driving south for 1.3 miles. Turn right onto Lincoln Street for 0.4 miles. Lincoln Center is located on the left.

#### For those coming in on Ridge Road or Route 30 —

**Ridge Road** to Indianapolis Blvd. Turn south for 0.3 miles. At the first stop light turn east on Lincoln St. for 0.1 miles.

Route 30 to Indianapolis Blvd. Turn north for 4.2 miles. Turn east on Lincoln St. for 0.1 miles.

The **Pair/Team game** is an exciting event for players of all levels. The pair portion of the event is played as a regular match point game. In the team portion of the event, the players starting at your table will be your teammates. Come as a team or a pair. Pairs without teammates will be matched up by the director. Each pair will receive a score for the pair portion of the game and another score for the team portion. This is a win/win situation for players. Players receive the higher number of points earned. For example, if in the pair game a pair earns 1.12 points but in the team game they earned 4.5 points, the pair will be awarded the 4.5 points!

Many bridge competitors view the **Knockout Team game** as the ultimate test in bridge. A Compact Knockout shortens the event to two sessions. Every entering team will play two rounds in the morning. All early rounds will be head-to-head or round-robin. The four most successful teams will advance to the afternoon session, where they will compete for the top four places. The two teams who lose in the third round (first half of the afternoon session) will play each other for third place, which pays better than fourth place.
